Registrations: Please register by 10 September! If you don't register we will do our best but we CANNOT guarantee a place. We need to tell Cricket ACT in advance of the season our team numbers. This does NOT apply to In2Cricket players, they can register any time.

Fees are \$120 for Regular Season (Under 9 to Under 18) and \$70 for In2Cricket. This season your fees include a club cap for each under age player, or a Cricket Australia kit for In2Cricket players. These caps will be handed out by your coach/manager at your first game for the season. Discounts apply for more than one sibling in Regular Season and In2Cricket as follows:

To calculate the cost, determine how many Under Age players (first) and then how many In2Cricket players (total of 3 max, any remaining players are free). The cost is shown where the column (Under Age) and row (In2Cricket) intersect. General discounts already factored in are:
2 players 30% approx and
3 players 45% approx.

Fees are able to be kept down in part due to the sponsorship provided by Magpies Sports Club. This year there has been a small fee increase, the first in 5 seasons, due to some cost increases.

Problems Paying? If you have any problems paying fees please contact the registrar or treasurer BEFORE registering. Any player who has not paid fees will be issued a fees notice. If this is not responded to they will not be able to play.

Grading: Under 11s and up teams are put into grades. We do try where possible to place friendship groups in the same teams; however this is not always possible due to different playing abilities. Grading is conducted by independent selectors. Grading session times are as follows, all at Kippax Oval:

Under 16/18 Colts

This is a combined Division 1 competition for the Under 16 and 18 Age groups. There will also be a separate single division competition for each of these age groups.

Age Groups, game times and formats: Your age group is determined by your age on 1 September (midnight). For example, if you turn 11 before 1 September 2010 then you are in Under 12. More detail about Under 9, 10 and 11 competitions are provided on our web site.

Privacy: Details provided on registration forms will only be used for the purposes of running the junior cricket club. Details will be passed to committee members, managers and coaches. Limited information will be passed to Cricket ACT and Magpies Sports Club. You can choose on the registration form to stop this occurring.

Equipment: Kits are provided to all teams. All you need to provide are whites. We recommend players have their own protector. All batsmen (except in In2Cricket) must wear helmets. No helmet, no play at training or games. U9 to U11 must also wear helmets when keeping.

Clothing: A range of club clothing (caps, playing shirts, training shirts and polo shirts) is available for purchase for players and parents, and can be ordered along with registration or on the club web site. The clothing is sold at cost. Please note that the new twenty20 competition for Division 1 teams will require each player to purchase and wear a coloured playing shirt. The club is investigating sponsorship arrangements that would reduce the cost of the shirt. More information will be provided at the grading days.

Wet weather: Official announcements of cancellations are made on <http://www.cricketact.com> and 1053 2CA; several other stations also announce cancellations. Unless announced on the web site or radio or you are contacted with a cancellation then presume that cricket is on.

Volunteers Needed: We are always looking for more volunteers, and we're particularly short in the younger age groups. This season several committee members have moved on and you will notice that there are a number of important positions still unfilled. If you are interested in committee position, coaching or managing please let a committee member know. The club subsidises new coaches to attend a level 1 coaching course at the start of the year.
